We pray for the members of our parish family that are celebrating birthdays, especially *Carter Francis, Catherine Uffen, Lorraine Colbeck, Trish Taylor, Nancy Packham, Pat Hagedom, Polly Bohdaneyzky*, and anniversaries: *Linda and Larry Dietrich* that they may always rejoice and give thanks for the blessings in their lives.
